Characteristics of the harvest

The 2019 vegetative cycle was preceded by the April rains. However, from the middle of spring until the end of summer, the year was characterised by scarce rains and temperatures that were higher than expected. The harvest began after a few rainy days, which helped to balance the grapes' composition and resulted in a year of extraordinary quality and optimal health.

Winemaking process

Its alcoholic fermentation is made at a controlled temperature in steel tanks for 26 days followed by malolactic fermentation for 30 days in French oak barrels. It is aged in French oak barrels.

Tasting notes

Intense cherry red cherry color very covered. The nose shows the impact of the climate of the vintage with spicy nuances and aromas of black fruit perfectly integrated. In the mouth it is a wine of balance, with warmth but at the same time with weight and power. A great varietal red wine with an excellent evolution in the glass.
